Restriction of Hazardous Substances (China-RoHS)

Dear Madam/Sir,

We've assessed our products in accordance with the Directive SJ/T 11363-2006 (China-RoHS) and in close cooperation with our suppliers. According to the information provided by our raw material suppliers, you can find the detailed declaration below

- Screwed cable fittings and accessories made of brass have a lead content of 2–3,5 percent. As such lead content is required for machining and is present in the metal in solid and bound form, it does not constitute an environmental hazard. Only the evaporation of brass could pose a danger, as lead might then be released in noxious form. According to the RoHS Directive, a lead content of 4% is permitted.
- Chromium-plated products contain chromium VI salts, but the overall concentration limit is below 0.1%.
- Our plastic products contain neither pentabromium derivatives (CAS no. 32534-81-9) nor octabromium derivatives (CAS no. 32536-52-0).
- Our products do not contain cadmium or mercury.
- PBB, PBDE and Deca-BDE are also substances that are not contained in our products.

Our products will be sold as components only for manufacturing. According to the Electronic Industry Standard SJ/T 11364-2014 our products and packaging are not directly marked.

We provide this information to the best of our knowledge and belief and in accordance with the current state of the art. However, it does not represent any warranty in the legal sense.
